PAINTBALL SPORTS

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW DOES IT WORK? On arrival everyone signs in and is issued with camo overalls, ammo belt, paintballs and a safety mask. Once everyone is kitted up, the group will receive a detailed safety brief before being issued with their semi auto Paintball Gun. The group will be split into 2 teams and given coloured arm bands. The Referee will then escort the group to the first playing field, conducts a gun demonstration and explain the rules of the game. Games last for around 10 to 15 minutes with breaks in between to re-hydrate and laugh about the last battle! We will play as many games as we can on any of the 8 playing fields. If extra paintballs are required, we can get them on the field at any time and they will be recorded on your dog tags. When we have had enough for the day, we will head back to headquarters to return the equipment, hand in the Dog tags for payment and settle back for a snag and a chat.

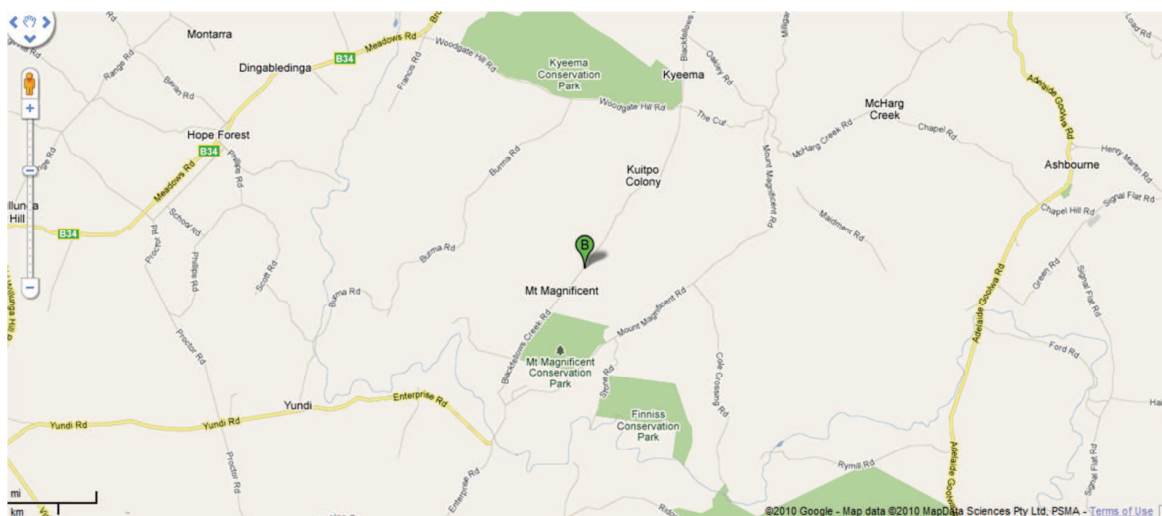
WHAT DO I WEAR? We suggest you wear loose fitting clothing or jeans, a t-shirt and outdoor shoes with good ankle support. All footwear must be enclosed. Full camouflage overalls are provided. You may bring a hat, scarf or gloves if you wish.

HOW MANY PAINTBALLS WILL I USE? This is entirely up to the individual. Most people use around 300 - 700 paintballs, so allow \$70-\$140 for an awesome day out.

CAN I BRING MY OWN PAINTBALL GUN? Yes, but you must present you firearms licence and gun registration.

HOW SAFE IS PAINTBALL? At Paintball Sports, **YOUR SAFETY** is their **NUMBER ONE PRIORITY** and they pride themselves on their safety record.

WHERE THEY ARE. The Kuitpo field is located south of Adelaide off the Victor Harbor Road; about 25 minutes' drive from the Southern expressway. Follow the Victor Harbor Road toward Mt. Compass. 6 km before Mt. Compass turn left onto Yundi Road. Follow the signs on Yundi Road to the end and then turn left over the bridge. Follow this road for 3.5km. They are the first property on the right after the conservation park.



Timing Training Night



Wednesday 11th August at the Clubrooms

Commencing at 8:00pm sharp

This session **precedes** the August General Meeting and should be approximately 45 minutes in length and will be conducted by SDCC's Chief Timekeeper Shane Groeke.

All interested members are urged to attend so that we have a cluster of "nearly Chief" timekeepers for the many events that we conduct. This will enable Clerks of Course to have the best available timing system provided for their event and also have people who are familiar with the TAG Heuer Professional Timing System which will include the results calculation.

As this is the first session we have conducted for the full timing system it will be a suck it and see as to the outcomes.

The set-up for the Photocell with reflector has been covered for people who have assisted at the Mt Alma Mile Hillclimbs, Adelaide Hills Tarmac Rallies and also the khanacross and autocross events at Lanac Park. These units are very similar to the photocells used at the many Classic Adelaide events along with Rally of South Australia.



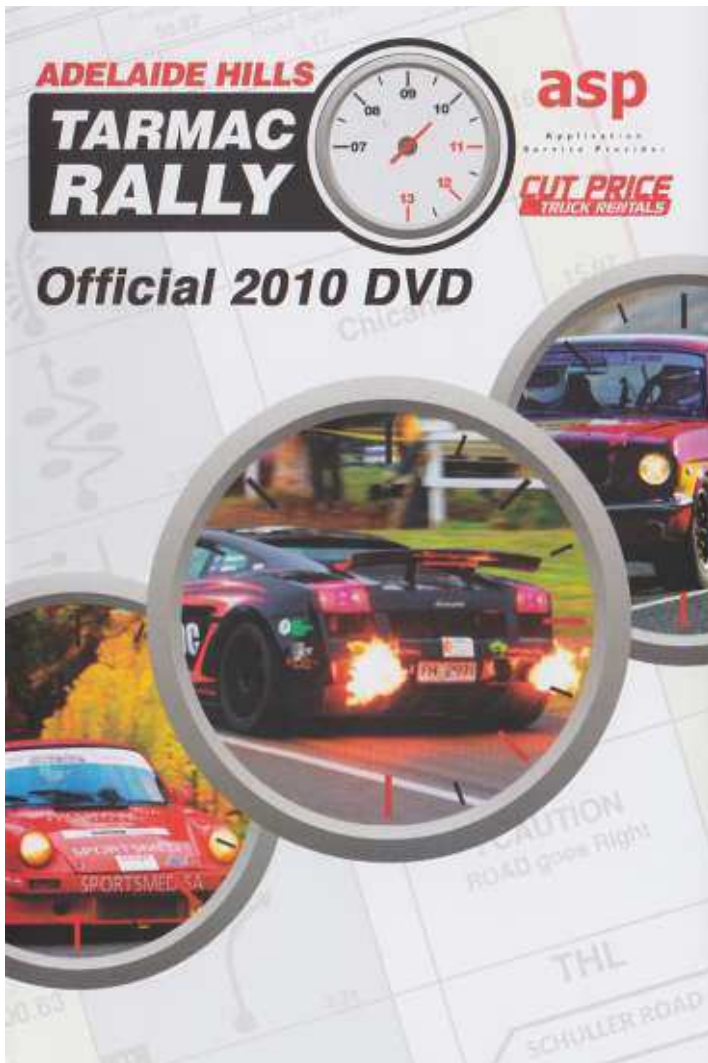
The chronoprinter (a fancy name for the timing device) we have is the TAG Heuer Chronoprinter 540 also used at the SDCC events listed above. For those who have performed timing duties at Classic Adelaide and Rally of South Australia, it will look familiar but it is a newer and updated model. Most of the operation for our model is very similar to these. The major difference being that there are two additional inputs/outputs at the rear of the device and therefore additional buttons on the front to utilise these features.

The final piece in the jigsaw is the TAG Heuer results calculation program which I must confess I do not know much about but after this session I hope that I will know more. Especially since for the khanacross on Sunday 22nd of August, Shane will be unavailable for.

So if you want to know about the best, please attend on Wednesday. See you there.
