1.4 Judges of Fact Refer to Series Regulations

Article 3. **EVENT DETAILS**

- 3.1 The South Australian Sprint Rally Series (hereafter referred to as the Series) will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of CAMS, the National Rally Code, CAMS Stage 1 Rally Sprint Standing Regulations, the current South Australian Conditions of Rallying, these Standing Regulations, the Event Supplementary Regulations and any other Further Regulations or Bulletins. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.
 Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.
- 3.2 Where there is any divergence between the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, these Series Regulations and the Event Supplementary Regulations, the Event Supplementary Regulations will take precedence.
- 3.3 The CAMS Permit Number authorising the event is 516/2108/02, which will be displayed on the official notice board at the event.
- 3.4 The length of the rally will be approximately 47 kms including 12 stages which have a total competitive distance of approximately 45 kms. All special stages are of a gravel/dirt surface, held in the Mid Murray Council on private roads.
- 3.10 Timing method will be a minimum resolution of one tenth of one second. Start times will be on the minute, and finish will be electronic beam. The event type is a Multi-club Stage 1 Rally Sprint.

Article 4. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

4.1 Refer to Series Regulations

Article 5. CREW ELIGIBILITY

5.1 Crew Crews shall comprise of two persons both being the holders of a minimum CAMS Level 2S licence, CAMS Level 2SE single event licence (Available from secretary on the day) or equivalent. The minimum age for drivers and co-drivers in Rally Sprints is 14 years. Please note that Junior Drivers will need an experienced Co-Driver and proof of experience will need approval by the Clerk of Course.

 - acts of violence and other harmful acts (whether intentional or inadvertent) committed by persons attending or participating in the event; and
 - the failure or unsuitability of facilities (including grand-stands, fences and guard rails) to ensure my safety.

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY, RELEASE & INDEMNITY

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the Motor Sport Activities, I agree:

- to release CAMS and the Entities to the extent that any or all of them are providing Recreational Services from all liability for:

 - b) any **physical or mental injury** (including the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of such an injury);
 - c) the contraction, aggravation or acceleration of a disease;
 - d) the coming into existence, the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of any other condition, circumstance, occurrence, activity, form of behaviour, course of conduct or state of affairs:
 - i. that is or may be harmful or disadvantageous to me or the community; or
 - ii. that may result in harm or disadvantage to me or the community,

howsoever arising from my participation in or attendance at the Motor Sport Activities;

- to indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified the Entities to the maximum extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person; and
- to attend at or participate in the Motor Sport Activities at my own risk.

I understand that:

- nothing in this document excludes, restricts or modifies any rights that I may have as a result of significant personal injury that is caused by the Reckless Conduct of the Entities as the supplier of the Motor Sport Activities / Recreational Services;
- nothing in this document prevents the Entities from relying on any laws (including statute and common law) that limit or preclude their liability:
- nothing in this document excludes any term or guarantee which under statute cannot be excluded; however the liability of the Entities is limited to the minimum liability allowable by law;
- nothing in this document precludes me from making a claim under a CAMS insurance policy where I am expressly entitled
 to make a claim under that insurance policy; and
- CAMS has arranged some limited personal injury insurance coverage which may provide me with some protection for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities. However, I acknowledge and accept that the insurance taken out by CAMS may not provide me with full indemnity for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities, and that I may have to pay the excess if a Claim is made under an insurance policy on my behalf.  - b) a similar leisure time pursuit or any other activity that:
 - (i) involves a significant degree of physical exertion or physical risk; and
 - (ii) is undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure.
