- EVENT DETAILS

- 3.1 The MRF Tyres South Australian Rally Championship (hereafter referred to as the Series) will be Special Stage Rallies using A to A timing – event type (iii); as per National Rally Code 1.33. Held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of CAMS, the National Rally Code, the current South Australian Conditions of Rallying, these Series Regulations, Event Supplementary Regulations and any Bulletins that may be issued. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.
- 3.2 Where there is any divergence between the current [CAMS Manual of Motor Sport](#) (hereafter referred to as CAMS Manual), these Series Regulations and the Event Supplementary Regulations. The CAMS Permit Number authorising the event is 516/0105/01 which will be displayed on the official notice board at the event.
- 3.3 The length of the rally will be approximately 225kms, including 10 stages which have a total competitive distance of approximately 129kms. All special stages are of a gravel/dirt surface, held on ForestrySA roads and in the District Council of Yankalilla on (closed) public roads.
- It will be: MRF Tyres SARC 225kms total – 128kms competitive
Multi Club 150kms total - 93kms competitive

3.4 The Event will consist of one Heat on one day.

SERVICING AND REFUELLING

7.1 The maximum distance between nominated Service Parks and refuel zones will be approximately 76 kms (including 47 kms competitive).
